

Hello skydiver community!

After I was approached by many of you and now that my new work situation makes it possible at last, I am looking forward to be able to offer you a Photo-Video Seminar.

It is taking place in March in Alvor, Portugal. Not only do we have there great scenery for jumping, but also on the days when the weather prevents jumping, the Algarve offers other opportunities to improve your photo skills.

The exact date we are deciding together with the interested candidates, but it is very likely to be between the 8 and 11 of March.

The aim of the seminar is to improve skills at preparation for photo-video jumps with teams, AFF and tandems. Freeflyers as well as Bellyflyers can contribute their skills to help achieve the best results. In the skydiving foreground the freefall safety from free fall to landing and the recommendations of the german DFV.

Technical objective: to operate the cameras and the lenses in the foreground. Automatic mode is prohibited. After you are familiar with all the buttons there are you shall learn what potential formats the camera has. Things such as TV, AV, aperture, hardware, HDR, ISO and crop factors won't be met with shrug. Also EBV and cutting will be part of the course. Whoever hasn't understood this is the perfect candidate to sign up.

The cost is 199€ euro for the four day and night seminar. Accommodation not included ;-)

You need to bring your helmet camera, camera and video camera (don't forget the instruction manual) and your notebook! It would be helpful if the camera has a digital recording system to quickly assess the results. Again, I can help you select the right things in advance. I will try to get helmet cameras, but that's not 100% guarantee!

In order to help me, those who need help assembling all of these components need to register in advance. I work with X-Shut and Bonehead and we will try to find a solution without burning a grand! It is also possible to use the cheaper solution, by Contour HD camera system.
